

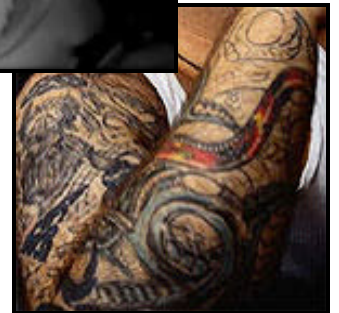
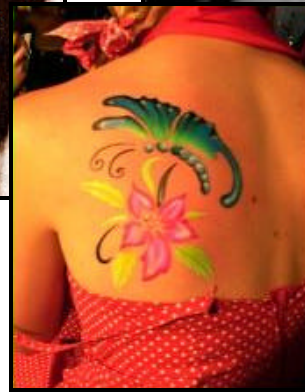
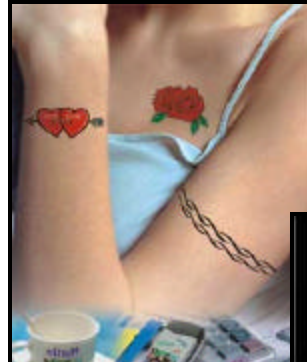

Dr. Horner is the Director of the Christian Study Center of Gainesville. He is a graduate of Covenant Theological Seminary and the University of Virginia, where he received a PhD in intellectual history under the direction of Richard Rorty. He has served as a pastor in the Presbyterian Church in America and has taught History and Philosophy at the University of Delaware and James Madison University. He also serves as a visiting professor at Reformed Theological Seminary in Orlando. Prior to assuming his role at the Study Center, Dr. Horner was a Research Fellow at the Institute for Advanced Studies in Culture at the University of Virginia. His interests include contemporary culture, the history of pragmatism and its Continental parallels, and biblical studies and Christian thought. He and his wife April live in Gainesville with their children, Rachel, Ken, and Jenna. He is also a graduate of Lakeland High School, and at the time of his graduation in 1970, his father, Kenneth A. Horner, was pastor of Covenant Presbyterian Church.
